# Strategies For Protecting Indiana's Farmland

## Overview

This program will assist community leaders and landowners to balance the need for retaining a viable farming industry in their localities with expanding non-farm development. Topics will include: zoning ordinances being implemented around the state to protect agriculture, land use models and zoning models to help local officials more effectively and efficiently plan for future growth in agriculture and other industries, and discussion of legislation introduced in recent Indiana legislative session to provide farmland protection incentives for landowners. Future legislation efforts and needs for providing farmland protection incentives will also be discussed. Some planning tools to be discussed include differentiated agriculture zones, protective agricultural zones, and funding sources for farmland protection. Participants will be encouraged to ask questions and share their thoughts and needs for providing farmland protection in their communities.
