



DEEP RIVER DAM FEASIBILITY STUDY

Public Meeting

The Northwestern Indiana Regional Planning Commission (NIRPC) will be holding the final public meeting for the Deep River Dam Feasibility Study on Tuesday, May 15th. The feasibility study is the first step in exploring the potential modification or removal of the low head dam located on Deep River near Liverpool Road. NIRPC and Flatland Resources will be providing an update on project findings, recommended action, and next steps.
